

The Rainforest



Rainforests can be found on every continent except Antarctica, but many are found in South America, Asia, and Pacific islands. There are two major types of rainforests. One is a tropical and second is a temperate. Each rainforest consists of four layers: emergent, canopy, understory, forest. The average temperature in the rainforest is 77 degrees Fahrenheit and the amount of rainfall is between 50 and 250 inches per year. Some animals you can find in

the Rainforest are: gorillas, toucans, jaguars, and red-eyed tree frogs.
