Creating a bar code

You need Three (3) things:

- 1) A smart phone and or an iPad that can read QR Barcodes.
- 2) A barcode scanner (<u>Scanlife</u>) (<u>Redlaser</u>). Both are free and you may download them from here or from the website (<u>Working with</u> <u>iPads</u>). I am sure there are more but have not done the research to determine if one is better than the other.

To get started it is really quite easy. I normally make a video but not sure if you need one for this!

- 1. Go to that website listed above.
 - a. Look at the text box below the barcode and type in anything you want. The more you type in the more code in the box!
 - b. Click on Create Bar Code. Take your scanner and pass it over the code.
 - c. You may copy the Bar Code and paste it on your paper for students to use.
