Directions for creating puzzle with straight lines using Microsoft Word

- 1. Take picture of students and save to a folder
- 2. Open up Microsoft word
- 3. Go to Insert picture --- from you folder of students
- 4. Click on the photo of student and WRAP TEXT -- behind text
- 5. Adjust size of Photo
- 6. Go to website and copy grid that has straight lines 32 squares
- 7. Past grid over students face
- 8. Click on grade and use WRAP TEXT -- PLACE IN FRONT OF TEXT
- 9. Move grade down and click on photo and at the top you will see the word FORMAT
- 10. More cursor over to the left and click on COLOR
- 11. SCROLL down to **SET TRANSPARENCY COLOR this will make the grid transparent so you may see the photo below**
- 12. Grab the handles of the grid and adjust so the grid covers the photo only.
- 13. Save you picture so you do not lose it.
- 14. Make more image puzzles of students
- 15. PRINTOUT ON THICKER PAPER
- 16. Since the lines are straight you or your students may easily cut each square that is sued for the puzzle
