## *Directions for using Chrome Book*

In this lesson you will create an interactive nonlinear presentation. You will only discover 4 slides to work with but, learning from the 4 slides will allow you to create a slide presentation in the future with as many slides as necessary.

- 1) We have placed some example questions and answers in the video. You may adjust your questions and answers to whatever school subject, area, or theme you are interested in. All slides must be hyperlinked and each slide should have a question and answer. Remember we have provided a video to accompany this lesson to assist you. Remember that you may copy parts of the lesson so you do not have to recreate. You may click on a slide and hit Control D to duplicate that slide. Save your lesson often so you do not lose what you have worked on.
- 2) When you click on the link it will automatically download to a download folder on your computer. 2) Open up your google account. 3) Create a folder in your google account drive, called *Slides Lesson-3*. 4) Place the cursor in this folder and click on NEW file upload at the top of your screen, you will find your lesson listed in the download folder click open and it will be transferred to your account. 5) Click on open with Google docs and it will convert your presentation. 6) You are not ready to work on your presentation. Remember we have provided a video to accompany this lesson to assist you.
