HOW TO CREATE A WORD WALL ACCOUNT FOR YOU AND YOUR STUDENTS MAY CREATE THEIR OWN ACCOUNT

1. Go to the word wall account on my main page. It does not matter which one you choose (Elementary or Middle High school). You will click the WORD WALL WEBSITE AT THE STOP OF



THE PAGE. Click on that link and it will take you to the login and sign up page.

- 2. You will need to sign up into the word wall the first time. You only need your email account and a simple password. If I may suggest 123456, something you will **REMEMBER**. Once you have signed up you will only need to LOG IN with your email and password from now on. The account will keep track of your number of lessons (you only have **5 free** lessons with this email account unless you purchase their package or use another email account).
- 3. If you click on <u>CREATE AN ACTIVITY</u> you may now start from scratch as it will show you quite a few template to choose from. You do not need to use this if you will read further.
- 4. If you log in first then you may now go to my website where I have many lessons for examples for all grades and subjects. If you choose one of my lessons you will only need to click EDIT and you now may enter in your own information for your lesson. My video will show you what I am in reference to what you're doing. This will allow you to quickly create a lesson for your grade level and subject. This will provide your students and parents with the understanding that you have designed their lessons.
- 5. Make sure you change the name at the top so it does say copy. Place what you wish to call the lesson. When you have completed the lesson, you will then be able to change the background design of the lesson and also some more details that will be provided for you in the video.
- 6. When you are ready to post your lesson CLICK **SHARE** and you may now choose the grade level and subject that will be provided for you. Post the lesson and you will be provided the link to your lesson which you may now save and or post. You may wish to post it on a word document that you may edit and save so that the your name is at the top along with the name of the lesson and the link below.
