

## **Directions for creating lesson in WORD WALL**

**NOTE: We have created a WORD WALL instructional video for you to use also!**

1. Go to word wall website you may click on in the elementary or middle school link.
  2. You will see the word WORD WALL click on it.
  3. Sign in for an account with your email ( You may use up to 5 free lessons)
  4. Look over all the templates. You don't need to use them if you wish to **EDIT MY LESSONS. IF SO DROP DOWN TO USING MY EDIT IT FOR DIRECTIONS IS EASIER FOR YOU.**
  5. Decided which template is best suited for your grade level and subject.
  6. After you have choose which template you want at the very top of the webpage you will discover a list choose **CREATE AN ACTIVITY**
    - a. ***When you have chosen you template will allow you to make adjustments to it. It may better if first you create your questions and answers on a word document first then you may copy them to the website.***
  7. Make sure you have placed a solid name for your quiz.
  8. Should have a minimum of 10 Questions
  9. Play the game and make sure it is correct.
  10. You will be asked to click on the grade or grades that may use your lesson.
    - a. If it is not correct you will discover an EDIT link below the lesson
  11. Once your lesson is how you want it you will discover below the lesson quite a few backgrounds for your project. Decided which is best suited for your lesson, grade level and students.
  12. When you click share your lesson you will be able to copy the link
    - a. Make sure you save your link on a word document so you will always have it
    - b. If you are creating this lesson for graduate credit send the following by email.
    - c. NAME OF QUIZ AND LINK AND GRADE LEVEL
8. Choose your background for your lessons



## **MY EDIT**

- 1. Log in to your account first.*
- 2. Go to one of my lessons or someone else's that has been created.*
- 3. Click on the word edit*
- 4. Change the title to what the lesson is about.*
- 5. and you may delete the current numbers, words or questions and place your own.*
- 6. Click on the word Share when done – Choose the grade or grades levels for you lesson and what the lesson is covering—Example English, Math Social Studies. When you publish save the link and you may now use it to display your work. If you made a mistake you may always hit edit and correct your error.*
- 7. The lesson you just created will be stored in you account that you may go back to and see it.*
